Safety and **Community Outings**

A community outing is defined as any trip or social engagement where the destination is outside of one's home setting, in the community. Community outings may vary based on modes of transportation, group sizes, and destinations.

Studies show that there are health benefits associated with participating in one's community. Benefits for seniors may include: Fostering support networks, maintaining physical independence, mental stimulation, preventing social isolation, reducing the risk of depression, and improving quality of life!

There may also be safety issues involved with traveling outside of one's home. Examples of safety issues include: Falls, potential for injury, getting lost, difficulty with community barriers (such as unlevel surfaces, curbs, steps, ramps, and bathroom accessibility), poor endurance/fatigue, difficulties with assistive devices, continence issues, visual deficits, and memory concerns.

Good safety awareness and preparation are essential in assuring that the benefits of community outings outweigh the risks. Therapy can help bridge the gap between a resident wanting to participate (but having safety concerns) and confidently participating in community outings. Physical and occupational therapists are specially trained to help residents maximize their independence and achieve their goals.



Therapy Interventions May Include:

- Safety awareness assessment and interventions
- Community integration training, in order to practice challenging skills that are required during the desired outing. This can include a therapist accompanying you on an outing to assess performance and make real-time safety recommendations.
- Adaptive equipment assessments, attainment, and training
- Balance, strength, and coordination training for fall prevention
- Caregiver education and hands-on training for a family member or friend who may be accompanying you on an outing.

An American Symbol

With his white hair, beard and patriotic top hat and tailcoat, Uncle Sam is an iconic symbol of America.

The character is linked to New York meat packer Samuel Wilson, a wellliked businessman nicknamed Uncle Sam. During the War of 1812, he supplied barrels of beef to the U.S. Army. When soldiers saw "U.S." stamped on his barrels, indicating United States property, they assumed the letters stood for Uncle Sam, and the name became synonymous with the U.S. government.

Political cartoonist Thomas Nast popularized the image of Uncle Sam in the 1870s, drawing him with chin whiskers and a suit adorned with stars and stripes. In 1916, artist James Montgomery Flagg created the most well-known portrait of the national symbol. A stern-faced Uncle Sam, his finger pointing at the reader, first appeared on a magazine cover. The next year, the image was used with the caption "I Want You for U.S. Army" on World War I recruitment posters. More than 4 million copies of the poster were printed. Versions of Flagg's Uncle Sam were also used as a call to action during World War II.
