## Understanding Medicare from Legacy Healthcare

Medicare has been around since 1965 and is health insurance for people aged 65 and older, those with certain disabilities, and people with End-Stage Renal Disease (ESRD).

Original Medicare is run by the Federal Government and provides Part A and Part B coverage. Part A, also known as "hospital insurance" pays for services provided by an inpatient



hospital, skilled nursing facility and hospice. Part B, also known as "medical insurance" covers 80% of doctors' visits and outpatient care such as therapy and other medical expenses. You can also join a prescription drug plan under Medicare Part D.

Medicare Part C offers coverage provided by a Medicare Advantage Plan. These plans typically involve a copayment to be paid by the beneficiary.

Confusion about your health care coverage should not prevent you from receiving the rehab services you may need. Stop by the Legacy Healthcare Therapy Services Office today.
